- If is possible, drink tap water and USE A CANTEEN to carry it with you
- ALWAYS AVOID DISPOSABLE OBJECTS such as plates, cutlery and plastic cups or use them in biodegradable materials
- STORE FOOD IN REUSABLE CONTAINERS. avoid the film
- AT THE OFFICE, USE YOUR CUP AND YOUR GLASS
- REMEMBER TO DO GARBAGE COLLECTION. even when you are out of home
- USE A REUSABLE BAG FOR YOUR PURCHASES
- CHOOSE SOAPS AND DETERGENTS IN RECYCLABLE **PACKAGES**
- CHOOSE NATURAL FIBERS for your clothes
- GIVE UP WITH STRAWS
- TAKE PART IN CLEANING INITIATIVES OF BEACHES **AND SEABEDS**
